

Welcome to 8th grade Science! The units we will cover this year will be Matter, Physics, and Astronomy and they are also NGSS aligned. In this handout, I will explain how this class works. Consistency and organization are keys to succeed in this class.

Grading: My grading policy is simple: Total points earned divided by total points possible.

ABCDE's: there will be a quiz on the following:

"A": Arrival, Attendance, Absence

- QUIET arrival is expected (Arrive on time!)
- You must be seated before the bell rings. You might be marked tardy otherwise.
- Once seated, you must take out your planner, lab book, homework and sharpened pencil.
- Write down the "homework" section from the front board into your planner.
- During the **first 20 minutes** of each class no one may get up for any reason.
- **ABSENCES - check my website when you are absent.** There are no make-up labs. You are responsible for any missed material when you return from being absent. Check my website and check in with me for notes/handouts/data. If you are absent on a test day you will be expected to take it the day you return. You may take a test once only. Homework that was assigned when you were present but due the day you were absent will be due the next block day. Late work will not receive more than 50% of the points possible.

"B": Behavior, Books(lab and SSR), Bathroom, Binder

- NO GUM!!! NO FOOD!! NO PERFUME ALLOWED!! ONLY WATER IS ALLOWED!!
- **Be** prepared every day with **your own colored pencils, ruler, glue stick, binder, lab book, pencil**
- **Be** respectful in this classroom. **Behave.** There will be no running, pushing, bullying, throwing objects.
- You must bring your lab book and an SSR book every day.
- **Lab books:** you will need to bring a **70 page** composition/lab book to class every day. **DO NOT GET A NOTEBOOK WITH PERFORATIONS!** Your name must be clearly marked with a sharpie on the front cover. Do not lose your lab book, get it wet, or leave it at home. You must write in **PENCIL ONLY**. All notes will be written in your lab book - **IN ORDER!** Turn in lab book at end of year!
- **Science Binder:** You must have a science binder or a science section in a larger A/B day binder and keep this organized too. It will contain all handouts, quizzes, and homework. At the end of each unit, the binder may be emptied and all material inside are to be kept in your folder in the back of room 18. **DO NOT EMPTY YOUR BINDER AT HOME! KEEP EVERYTHING IN YOUR SCIENCE BINDER!!**
- **GOING TO THE BATHROOM:** you need to use the restroom before class (at break or at lunch).

"C": Communication/Check, Chairs, Classwork, Colored Pencils:

- "Wheeling around" is not allowed in the classroom and will result in a **Science Detention**.
- Be careful when you stand up because the chair might roll back and move before you sit back down.
- Put all electronics and lab materials on the counter **BEFORE MOVING** furniture (When instructed).
- **Class work - turn in all class work at the front table (bin):** You must use your class time wisely.
- You must have your own set of **colored pencils** for your labs and notes
- **Check your Grades.** GRADES - check your grades online regularly. Any **missing work** will be "zeroed out" at the end of each grading period. **Once it is "zeroed out", you may no longer turn it in.**

"D" Departure, Detention, Deadlines:

- I will only **dismiss** the class when everyone is in their seats.
- No one can be seated for dismissal until all lab equipment is cleaned and returned appropriately. Dry up any area that is wet.
- All items on the floor under and around your seating area - whether it is YOURS OR NOT, must be cleaned before departure.
- Science has its own closed detention system. Aeries will also record theses detentions.
- Cheating or copying will result in a detention.
- Only science teachers will administer science detention slips.
- Detention will be held from 11:50 - 12:10 on Friday afternoons.
- You must arrive on time and give the pink slip to the teacher who is doing detention that Friday.
- **Detention** will be in room 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, or 20. The slip will tell you which room will hold detention.
- 1st offense=warning & lunch detention, 2nd= email/call home & lunch detention, 3rd= Office Referral
- If you become a "frequent flyer" in the detention system, harsher consequences will follow.
- **Deadlines:** you are not allowed to turn in work after deadlines. Deadlines will be posted in the class and on my website.

"E": Electronics; extra credit, etc

- **Do not take out iPad until instructed to do so.** Not following this rule, will lead to a detention.
- CELL PHONES are NOT allowed. They must be turned off and remain in your backpack.
- Please follow instruction with all digital devices. Stay on task. No taking pictures/videos unless directed to do so. **Your iPad must be charged for school (science detention).**
- Apps are to be used when instructed - do not "play" games on iPads.
- Extra Credit: it is not given
